Presentation of the Faculty of Nursing Sciences, University of Health Sciences of Lao PDR



The Faculty of Nursing Sciences (FON) is under the aegis of the University of Health Sciences of Lao PDR (UHSL), Ministry of Health. This faculty was established in 2008 and is divided into 5 departments: Administration and Academic Affair, Fundamental and Community Nursing, Pediatric Nursing, Adult-Geriatric Nursing and Psychiatric Nursing, Midwifery. Its objective is to train health professionals, nurses and midwives, to the highest level available in Laos (Bachelor of Science). It offers initial and continuous education in these two fields.

More specifically, in the midwifery department, two study programs are offered to obtain a Bachelor's degree in midwifery:

- The initial training programlasts 4 years. There are theoretical and practical courses composed of theoretical modules, a thesis, hospital internships and a final evaluation.
- The second program is for continuous education. It consists of continuous training for nurses or midwives. This training course is carried out over 2 years.

FON has a national and international network with links to healthcare facilities and universities.

Presentation of Mae* project (*mother in Lao)

The project to support midwifery training aims to form a visible and concrete bridge between midwifery training and the improvement of mother and childcare throughout Laos.

The project will

- Strengthen the capacity of human resources in mother and child health in Lao PDR at all levels (central, provincial, pre-service and in-service training), building on teaching staff already trained
- Raise awareness and inform the general population and the medical profession of the importance of access to quality mother and childcare by relying on the network of bachelor alumni
- Strengthen training and healthcare structures identified in the provinces to enable quality maternal and childcare

This approach should make it possible to achieve the common objective that the partners project have always set for themselves: to train with the aim of contributing to the improvement of public health of the population in the long term.

Mission and activities

Conducting the mission

The project manager will be under the technical supervision of the Fondation Pierre Fabre project manager. He/she will be in regular contact with the teaching staff of the midwifery department of the FSI, in particular the vice-dean. The local contract will be registered by the IRD Partner.

- Help in the implementation and follow-up of daily activities;

- Assistance in the purchase of consumables, teaching materials and equipment;
- Monitoring of indicators;
